















Step 3
With Left Partition Panel (J) flat on the floor (fixed drawer guide facing up), attach Wood Shelf (Q) using Wood Dowels (Part #1) and Cam Locks (Part #3) as shown.




Step 4
Turn assembled parts (J & Q) on their side. Attach Right Partition Panel (K) using Wood Dowels (Part #1) and Cam Locks (Part #3) as shown.




Step 5
Turn assembled parts (J, K & Q) on end with cutout notches facing up.
Attach Front Top Rail (L) to Panels (J & K) with Wood Dowels (Part #1) and Long Flat Head Screws (Part #13) as shown.




Step 6
With Back Bottom Rail (N) on a flat surface, attach Back Partition Rails (O) using Wood Dowels (Part #1).





Step 7 Insert Back Panels (P) into the grooves of Rails (N & O).




NOTE - Be sure that Back Panels (P) are completely inserted into the grooves of parts M, N & O.










Turn cabinet over with Rail (L) on a flat surface. Attach Base (Y) using Wood Dowels (Part#1) and Long Hex Socket Head Bolts (Part#7) as shown. Attach Legs (packaged separately) using Hex Socket Head Bolts & Wood Dowels (as shown in instruction manaul included with legs). Attach 2 Support Legs (Z) OR (ZA) to the Base (Y). Carefully turn cabinet over so that legs are now flat on the floor.


(Noted: Support Legs (ZA) are used only with Bun Foot; Support Legs (Z) are used with other styles feet.)






Attach Top(B)using Wood Dowels(Part#1) and Cam Locks(Part#3)as shown.











## SAFETY WALL STRAP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

- 1) Insert Short Screw Part (C) through Washer Part (B) and Safety Wall Strap Part (E) and screw it into the predrilled hole in the Part (A) of the cabinet.
- 2) Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure your cabinet. The hole should be at the same height as the hole in Part (A) of the cabinet. Tap Wall Anchor Part (A) into the hole.
- 3) Insert Long Screw Part (D) through a Washer Part (B) and Wall Safety Strap Part (E) into Wall Anchor Part (A).

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.
